Work of Art on Loan



Our school has been loaned an original painting dating back to the 17th century. It features a young boy, possibly royalty, standing tall in all his finery. Year 4 have used the painting to inspire their own Tudor portraits and heard what can be learnt from a piece of art from a local expert, David Ummels. The picture is on display in the main foyer and was a centre piece for the Year 4 Tudor Day this week. During the day the children dressed up, created Tudor pomanders, baked Tudor food and tried their hand writing using a quill. Family members were invited along to see the children's Tudor dancing, try their delicious (?) Tudor cooking and look at the animations the children had made about their learning. A great day was had by all and thankfully no broken teeth from munching on Tudor ship's biscuits!
